MUSIC DEPT. GRADING POLICY:

Major Assessments – Dress Rehearsals/Performances/Overall Participation & Commitment	45%
Class Preparation – Homework/Practicing your parts outside of class	15%
Class Participation – Attendance/Punctuality/Accuracy & Consistency during daily rehearsals	40%

Please Note: According to State regulations, in order for a student to receive high school credit, he or she cannot miss more than 10% of class meetings.

- 1. 100% ATTENDANCE IS REQUIRED FOR ALL DRESS REHEARSALS, AND PERFORMANCES. In case of illness, please provide a doctor's note. In the case of a personal issue, please provide a note from your parents. Please let me know in writing any foreseen absences at least one week in advance. Email and/or hard copy.
- 2. BEING EARLY = BEING ON TIME! My consistent <u>attendance</u> is the key to success in this class. I understand that being late more than 3 times during the semester will lower my grade significantly because I will lose 2 grade points for each subsequent lateness.
- 3. YOUR CLASS PARTICIPATION DEPENDS ON YOU BEING PREPARED!! Every day I need my instrument, music, reeds, mouthpiece, PENCIL WITH ERASER, and other accessories. I understand that points will be deducted from my final grade if I come to class unprepared more than 3 times during the semester.
- 4. CUTTING CLASS WILL RESULT IN DISPLINARY ACTION. I understand that cutting this class will significantly lower my grade and could result in dismissal from the class. I may fail if I have more than 3 unexcused absences.
